Shorter Catechism 63-66

Q. 67. *What is the sixth commandment?*  
**A. The sixth commandment is, “You shall not murder.”**  
Q. 68. *What is required in the sixth commandment?*  
**A. The sixth commandment requires all lawful efforts to pre-serve our own life and others’ lives.**  
Q. 69. *What is forbidden in the sixth commandment?*  
**A. The sixth commandment forbids the taking away of our own life or the life of our neighbor unjustly, as well as anything that tends to that.**
